Notes

1. Full details, passes, maps and other information will be provided on arrival. Assistance will be widely available during the programme.
2. The route and timings of trips may change for operational reasons outwith the organisers control.
3. Charges (Inclusive of VAT). Other than where indicated in the detailed programme, the package charges include local transport between Banchory, Inchmarlo and Crathes, charges for all events and activities, meals only where indicated, gratuities and guides.
4. Payment must be made in £ Sterling.
5. Payment should be made in full at time of booking. Full refunds (less credit card charges) will be accepted until 31st December 2022. Cancellations between 31st December 2022 and 31st March 2023 will incur a 5% charge and thereafter a 10% charge.
6. Certain events can be enjoyed without incurring the package charge. These individual event charges are shown on the reservation form.
7. The programme is provisional. If there are changes to the programme, appropriate amendments to the charges will be advised.
8. For many events there is a minimum/maximum capacity, as noted on the reservation form. Should it not be possible to proceed with an event or tour, an appropriate alternative or refund will be offered.
9. The Crathes Castle café/restaurant (licenced) is open during the daytime and will be open in the evening of Thursday 3rd August.
