# PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

## DAY 1

**Wednesday 29 July**

**Arrival & Welcome**

**Welcome Supper & Storytelling Evening**

Our Gathering begins with a relaxed welcome supper, bringing family together in a convivial setting.

The evening will include:

- A traditional Scottish welcome
- A short introduction to the Burnett story and the lands of Leys
- Professional storytelling, sharing Highland history and folklore
- A shared supper featuring local produce.







# DAY 2

**Thursday 30 July**

## **The Heart of the Estate**

A day centred on the lands, landscape and stories of the Burnetts of Leys.

### **Morning – Choose One**

#### **Castle & Gardens Walk**

A gentle guided walk through historic gardens and Castle, with time to pause, photograph and enjoy the setting.

#### **Loch of Leys Nature Walk**

A relaxed walk to the Loch of Leys with the possibility of accessing the Crannog - the man made island - on which the Burnetts lived when they arrived on deeside in the 14th century.

#### **Lunch on the Estate**

Guests will either gather for lunch at the Castle café or have a hosted lunch featuring locally sourced Highland beef and seasonal produce, served in an informal estate setting.

### **Afternoon – Choose One**

#### **Scolty Hill Walk**

For those who wish, a guided ascent of Scolty Hill, rewarded with panoramic views across Deeside and beyond. A steady pace, with time to enjoy the scenery.

#### **Estate & Family History Tour**

A more relaxed alternative, focusing on the Burnett family story, estate life past and present, and the social history of the area.

#### **Evening Concert**

Strathspey & Fiddle Society Performance

An evening of traditional Scottish music, showcasing the distinctive rhythms and melodies of the North East. An intimate and memorable cultural highlight.



# DAY 3

**Friday 31 July**

## **Castles, Coast & Culture Day Tours**

Guests may choose from one of three curated day tours, each offering a different perspective on the region.

### **Option 1 – Royal Deeside & Balmoral**

Explore the landscapes and heritage of Royal Deeside, including castles, villages and royal connections that have shaped the area for generations.

### **Option 2 – Dunnottar Castle & the Coast**

Visit the dramatic clifftop ruins of Dunnottar Castle, followed by time in a coastal town to enjoy sea air, scenery and local hospitality.

### **Option 3 – Aberdeen: City & Culture**

Discover Aberdeen's historic old town, galleries and maritime heritage, offering a more urban and cultural experience.

Coach transport and local guides will be provided for all tours.

## **Evening: Grand Ceilidh**

### **Ceilidh Supper & Dancing**

A traditional Scottish ceilidh evening with live band, experienced caller and supper.

- No dancing experience required
- Dances will be explained and walked through
- A sociable, joyful evening suitable for all ages

For many visitors, this is a highlight of the Gathering.





# DAY 4

## Highland Games & Farewell

### Aboyne Highland Games

Guests are invited to attend the Aboyne Highland Games — one of Scotland's most respected and authentic Games.

The Burnett Gathering will have a reserved base where guests can:

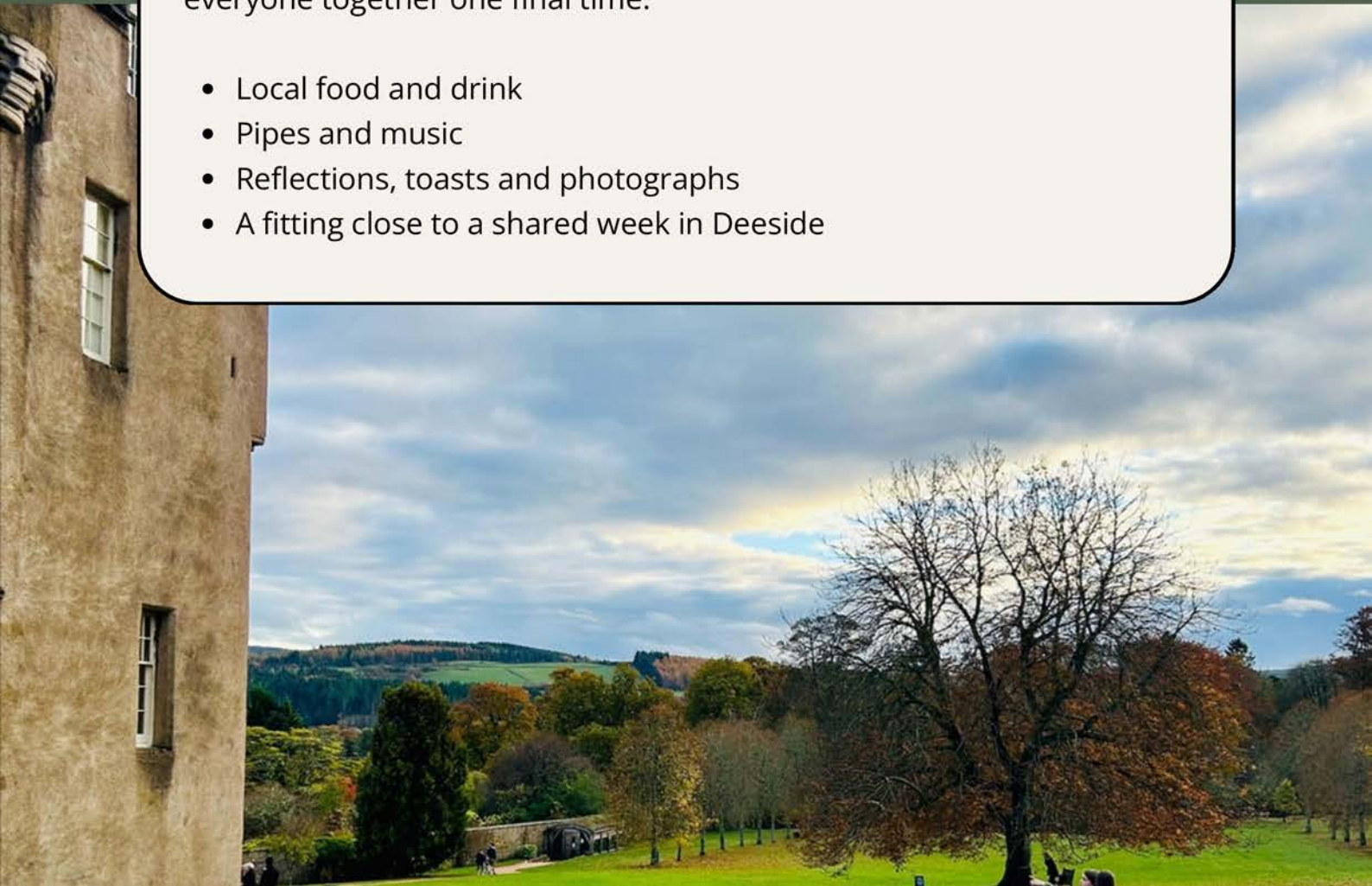
- Watch traditional athletic events
