Castle Tour

An intimate guided exploration of Crathes Castle, revealing its architectural features, collections, and the stories of the families who shaped its history.

Garden Tour

Loch of Leys & Crannog Site Tour

A guided walk to the Loch of Leys with the possibility of accessing the Crannog (weather dependant) - the man made island on which the Burnetts lived when they arrived in Deeside in the 14th Century.

Highland Cattle Experience

A relaxed introduction to Highland cattle, learning about traditional farming practices and the role livestock plays within the estate landscape.
